



WHY THE STARTING POINT

Three years on field and a +1000 participants research* taught us a lot.

- > Kids don't like mathematics due to a lack of engagement at school;
- > Kids don't like mathematics due to a lack o self-esteem.

BUT

- > Kids perceive mathematics as useful and exciting;
- > Kids want to be good at mathematics because it make them feel empowered.

That's why we believe that the methods currently used in Italy to teach mathematics are not the most effective ones.



WHAT A NEW TEACHING PILOT

Il Cielo Itinerante launches its summer camp in collaboration with Stanford University.

Mathematics is the universal language for the human being. So, we've studied how mathematics is taught in Italy and how it's taught around the world. Many innovative methods are arising, among them stands out the Youcubed method developed by the Stanford University.

- During our summer camps, kids will be exposed daily to this teaching method.
- > Impact pre and post will be assessed.

HOW THE PROGRAM

Train the trainer workshop

- Youcubed main goal is to inspire, educate and empower teachers of mathematics, transforming the latest research on maths into accessible and practical forms.
- The world-renowned Youcubed project is led by Professor Jo Boaler from Stanford University who will come in person to Italy to train the trainers.
- The trainers will be university and doctoral students pre-selected by Il Cielo Itinerante.

Summer camp

- In 2023 we will develop 4 summer camps in Naples and 1 in Milan, with 25 kids per camp;
- We will target **kids aged 11-13**, with a specific focus on areas of educational fragility;
- Summer camps will last 4 weeks and will include:
 - Daily mathematics class [3 hours];
 - Other activities such as space laboratories, sky observation, financial education, sports, and creativity.



WHERE & WHEN NAPLES & MILAN

The first five identified locations are in Naples and Milan.

The project will start in May 2023 following this timeline:

- > Second half of May // Train the trainer workshop
- > Half June half July // Summer camps
