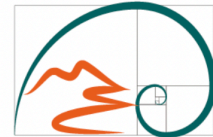

Mathematical Engineering Master Program a.y. 26/27:

GENERAL ADMISSION RULES

Italian students: Italian students can enroll at www.segrepass.unina.it

Extra-UE citizen: in order to apply for admission to the Master Degree Program in Mathematical Engineering at University of Naples Federico II, you must submit your application on the University portal www.universitaly.it. In this step the pre-acceptance letter is not necessary.

Applicants must have:

- a Bachelor's degree corresponding to the Italian qualification Laurea, awarded by an accredited foreign university and giving access to second-cycle courses; recommended background are in Mathematics or Engineering with a solid training in the core disciplines: mathematical analysis, algebra and geometry, physics, numerical analysis;
- a B2 English certification is also required as IELTS, PEARSON, TOEFL, UNIVERSITY of CAMBRIDGE ESOL, TRINITY, LCCIEB, CITY&GUILDS certifications obtained in the last two years;
- a letter of recommendation from a teacher expressly addressed to Mathematical Engineering course (subject to verification).

Once the students apply on University portal, the documents will be verified by the University International Office and by the Program Committee members in order to produce the pre-acceptance letter in case of eligibility. **Applicants will probably contacted for an interview with Program Committee members of the Mathematical Engineering Course to certify that the educational background is adequate according the requirements of the Master Program** (Art. 4 - Didactical Regulations: Admission requirements and knowledge required for access to the Degree Program. See: <http://www.mathematical-engineering.unina.it>).

After this preliminary application on the University portal, the International Office of our University will forward the pre-admission letter to the respective Embassy for visa request. It is important to remark that the candidate students will assume the status of actual students at the University of Naples Federico II only at the time of final enrollment in person at the students' office in Naples (Segreteria Studenti Area didattica Scienze MM.FF.NN. Complesso Universitario di Monte Sant'Angelo, Cupa Nuova Cintia, 21 - 80126 - Napoli).

Students are allowed to the academic career (specifically exams) only after that the B2 English certification has been verified by the University Language Centre (CLA) presenting one of the above mentioned certifications, otherwise students have to acquire the B2 English level by passing an exam taken at CLA.
